1	Welcome & Introduction Fitz Campbell opened the meeting by asking everyone to introduce themselves and mentioned this year's Mix event will take place on 14th August 2010 .

4	Site layout of The Mix JMcN gave a brief overall of layout of The Mix 2009 and highlighted on some of the pitches and tents there last year were Talkaoke/Cinema tent etc There were 2 stages and one was for the youth. The Met Police provided Karrot bus which had Wii games etc.
